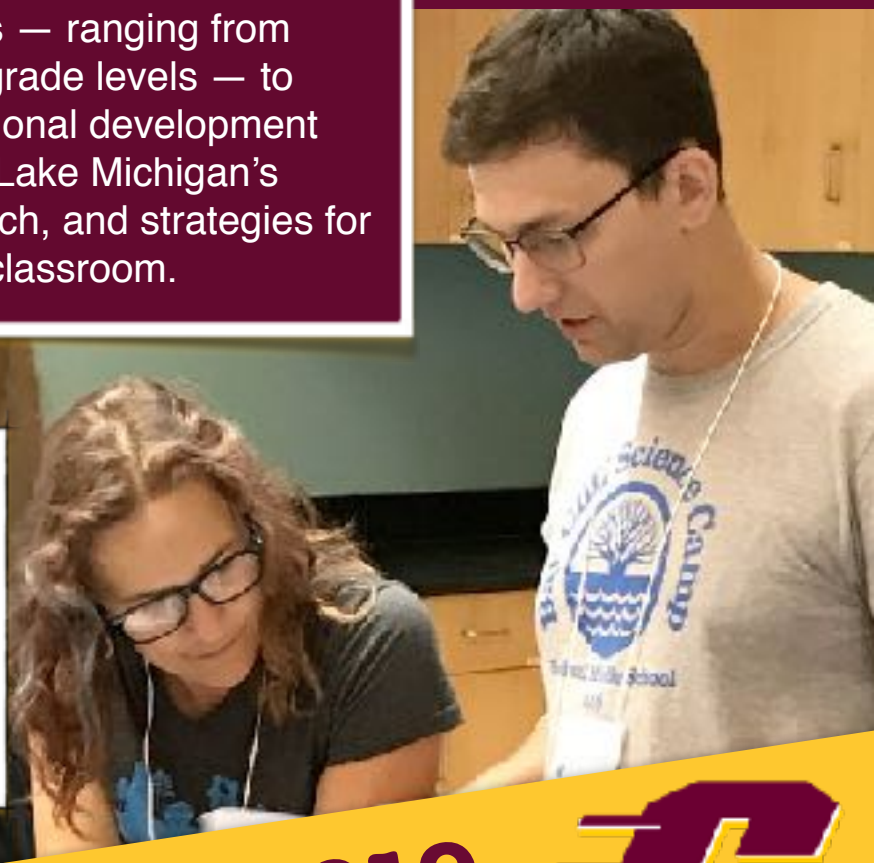


Central Michigan University 2019 Beaver Island Institute

Aug. 4-9, 2019

We welcome ELA and Science teachers — ranging from upper elementary to lower high school grade levels — to experience a unique, one-week professional development institute at CMU's Biological Station on Lake Michigan's Beaver Island. Study ecosystems, ed tech, and strategies for integrating reading and writing into the classroom.

We ask that all teacher teams interested in attending the Beaver Island Institute submit a free application that includes contact info and a brief description of your teaching context.

Registration costs for this experience — including ferry service to and from the island, room and board at the CMU Biological Station, and workshop expenses — is \$825. A \$100 non-refundable deposit will be due by May 1, with the remaining costs due by July 15. Participants will be responsible for travel to and from Charlevoix, Michigan.
